

STONECREST SOFTBALL FIELD RULES 2020-2021

The Stonecrest Softball Association has set forth the following guidelines for the upcoming 2020-2021 softball season. Due to the COVID outbreak, the following guidelines will be followed during softball games at Stonecrest.

PLAYERS/MANAGERS RESPONSIBILITIES

1) Visiting teams will limit their personnel to players, coaches and scorekeepers. A list of all attending players and visiting spectators is to be kept for effective contact tracing in the event a COVID-19 infection becoming known.

2) Players will bring their own personal equipment: gloves, towels and other personal items will not be shared among players.

3) The first row of bleachers next to the dugouts will be reserved for softball players. This will permit softball players to spread out in the dugout and the extended bench of the first row of bleachers.

4) Players should bring their own hand sanitizers.

5) No handshakes or other physical greetings will be permitted. Players will be encouraged to disperse and leave the area following the completion of their game.

6) Benches, gates, fences, etc. will be wiped down between games.

7) Teams should allow players from previous game to leave the dugout area before they enter.

8) Before each game, issue a reminder to players and spectators to follow safe social distancing and mask wearing guidelines.

FAN RESPONSIBILITIES

1) Visiting teams fans are discouraged from attending games.

2) The bleachers should only be used for player overflow from the dugout.

3) Stonecrest fans may park their golf carts down the left field foul line to watch the games. Fans may bring their own chairs and sit on the grass directly above home plate.

4) Stonecrest fans need to abide by social distancing rules, avoid gathering in small groups and to wear a mask when distancing is not possible.
