COVID19 – CORONA VIRUS

As a participant (player, umpire, coach, scorekeeping, announcer, grounds keeper, other family members, and/or spectator) in the Clerbrook RV and Golf Resort (CRGR), Clerbrook Softball Association (CSA) softball games and fundraising activities, it is understood that YOU have evaluated the risks associated with willingly being at and participating in a CSA softball game or other activities and therefore, YOU fully accept all risks, waive liability, and hold CSA and Clerbrook RV and Golf Park harmless in association with COVID19 – Corona Virus and its related illnesses and/or death.

CRGR and CSA highly recommends familiarizing yourself with and following the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and Prevention guidelines located at <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov> regarding COVID19 precautions while participating before, during, and after a CSA softball game. Based upon the CDC guidance, CSA suggest, but does not require, the following minimum precautions for all participants:

- *Wear an CDC approved mask at all times.*
- *Social distance, at least six (6) feet, from others whom you do not live or closely associate with.*
- *Wash and/or disinfect your hands throughout the game as appropriate.*
- *Use provided disinfection wipes on softballs, gloves, bats, and other equipment before each use or as appropriate.*
- *Each team should use only provided softballs during the game.*
- *Only team members at bat should retrieve foul balls hit out-of-play.*
- *Each team should use only equipment brought by that team (bats, gloves, etc.).*
- *Umpires should never handle a team's softballs or equipment.*
