

HOLIDAY VILLAGE SOFTBALL FIELD RULES 2020-2021

The Holiday Village Softball Association has set forth the following guidelines for the upcoming 2020-2021 softball season. Due to the COVID outbreak the following guidelines will be followed during softball games at Holiday Village.

PLAYERS RESPONSIBILITIES

- Visiting teams will limit their personnel to players, coaches and scorekeepers.
- No players will be permitted to share gloves.
- The first row of bleachers next to the dugouts will be reserved for softball players.
This will permit softball players to spread out in the dugout and the extended bench of the first row of bleachers.
- Hand sanitizer will be available in each dugout.
- Players should avoid making unnecessary contact with teammates, such as high fives and other celebrations.

FAN RESPONSIBILITIES

- Visiting teams' fans are discouraged from attending games.
- The bleachers will be closed (roped off) except for the first row used for the player overflow.
- Holiday Village fans may continue to park their golf carts down the left and right field foul lines like in the past years. Carts should be parked 6 feet apart.
- Holiday Village fans need to keep their distance and avoid gathering in small groups.

SNACK SHACK RESPONSIBILITIES

- Signs will be posted for proper spacing.
- Patio concrete will have tape marking proper distance while in line.
- Snack Shack workers will wear a face cover and plastic gloves.
- All condiments will be upon request and individually wrapped as well as utensils.
- All cash will be disinfected before returning to customers as change. (Lysol spray)
- Fans must wear face covering while ordering at the Snack Shack window.
- Snack Shack will continue to provide a container of hand sanitizer as in the past.
