

SPRUCE CREEK SOUTH SOFTBALL FIELD RULES 2020 – 2021

The Spruce Creek South Softball Club has set forth the following guidelines for the upcoming 2020 - 2021 softball season. Due to the COVID outbreak the following guidelines will be followed during softball games at Spruce Creek.

Spruce Creek South requests that no players, umpires, managers concession workers, spectators etc. that have been exposed to or exhibiting symptoms of Covid 19 be present at any game.

PLAYER RESPONSIBILITIES

- +Visiting teams will limit their personnel to players, coaches and scorekeepers.
- +No players will be permitted to share gloves.
- +The bleachers next to the dugouts will be reserved for softball players only. (This will permit players to spread out in the dugout and the extended bleacher area.)
- +Personal Protection Equipment is the responsibility of each player.
- +Players should avoid making unnecessary contact with teammates, such as high fives and other celebrations.

FAN RESPONSIBILITIES

- +Spruce Creek is requesting NO Visiting teams fans to attend games until further notice.
- +The bleachers will be closed for player overflow.
- +Spruce Creek fans are encouraged to come to the games but they need to bring their own seating and maintain proper social distancing.
- Golf Carts can be parked safely down the left and right field out of play lines.

CONCESSION STAND RESPONSIBILITIES

- +Signs will be posted for proper personal spacing.
- +Concession Stand workers will wear face masks and gloves.
- +All condiments will be upon request and individually wrapped as well as utensils.
- +Fans **MUST** wear face covering while ordering at the concession stand window. Failure to comply with these rules will result in not being served.
