A new Senior Softball League was formed on December 10, 1991 by the six charter teams:

These teams representatives will be responsible for managing their team in accordance with The League rules and deciding by majority vote any additional business, including admittance of new teams, that may come before The League. Meetings can be called by a majority of the teams representatives or at the discretion of The League President when required.

The goal of this league is to provide an opportunity for players living in adult communities to participate in a competitive fun slow pitch softball league dedicated to good sportsmanship, exercise and camaraderie with fellow athletes.

The League name will be Sun and Fun Senior League which is organized for the exclusive use of residents aged 55 years and older residing in adult communities containing 1000 habitable sites or less.

This League will start January 7, 1992 and will continue play through March 13, 1992, with games scheduled on Tuesday and Fridays.
