League rule 1.2 Proposed change Make up games caused by inclement weather will automatically be rescheduled for the next available open date.exceptions need approval of the operate division representative. all games will be made up before seasons end unless otherwise approved by the president. Regular scheduled games will have priority over make up games for starting times.

Vote 7 yes -7 no- 2 abstentions - deciding yes vote cast by PRES. Dave Sparrow Proposed change for rule 1.2 Passed

League rule 1.7 Proposed change reads: Team mangers will provide explanations for forfeited games to the appropriate divison representative. Unacceptable explanations will be forwarded to the league operating committee.

Vote - 13 yes -- 1 no -- 2 abstained

Proposed change for rule 1.7 passed.

League rule 2.2 Proposed change reads: Players must be at least 55 years old or turn 55 in the calendar year that the season ends. Each team is allowed no more than two players, who live in the member community to be 50 years old when they begin play.

Vote - 11 yes - 3 -no - 2 obtained.

Rule 2.2 passed.

Amendment to rule 2.2 - motion was made by Rick Smith 2nd by Ted Avery to read except for Mark Abrem who be grandfathered in. Amendment unanimously Passed.

Playing rule 3.2 Proposed change reads -- The runner must be any player in the offensive lineup. Vote - 8 – yes 6-no - 2 abstained. Rule 3.2 Passed as read.
