SUN LAKE, Fla. — In one of the most dramatic finishes of the season, Water Oak's Diversified Tree Service Lumberjacks traveled to Sun Lake to complete a February 17 protested game that had originally been played at Russell Field in Water Oak. What followed was a back-and-forth battle that kept fans on edge until the final swing.

When play resumed, Sun Lake held an 11-9 lead with Sun Lake coming to bat in the top of the eighth inning. The Lumberjacks refused to let the opportunity slip away. Showing the resilience that has defined their season, Water Oak pushed across two clutch runs in the eighth inning to knot the score at 11.

The tension mounted as both teams battled through a scoreless ninth inning. Neither side would give an inch, and the game stretched into extra innings.

Sun Lake struck first in the top of the tenth, plating two runs to take a 13-11 lead and placing the pressure squarely back on the Lumberjacks. But Water Oak answered with championship grit. In the bottom of the inning, the Lumberjacks mounted a furious rally, scoring three runs to walk it off in spectacular fashion, claiming a thrilling 14-13 victory.

The dramatic comeback did more than win a game. The victory pushed Water Oak 3½ games ahead in the standings with only three games remaining, mathematically clinching the 2026 Division 7 Sun and Fun Championship.

It was a fitting triumph for a team that has built its reputation on determination, teamwork, and the ability to deliver when the pressure is

greatest. On a morning that began with unfinished business, the Lumberjacks finished the job and secured their place atop Division 7.

FRIDAY THE 13TH FOG SETTLES OVER RUSSELL FIELD

It was a dark Friday the 13th in Water Oak as Division 7's Diversified Tree Service Lumberjacks suffered a rare setback, falling 10-5 to Continental West Financial. Even in defeat, however, the Lumberjacks maintain their hold on first place.

Continental returned to Russell Field for the second time this week, determined to avenge Tuesday's narrow 8-7 loss. This time, they left no doubt.

Water Oak struck first, taking a 1-0 lead in the opening inning and adding another run in the third to build a steady 2-0 advantage. The home crowd sensed another strong showing. Then the momentum shifted.

Continental erupted for four runs in the fourth inning, flipping the scoreboard and seizing a 4-2 lead. Stunned but resilient, the Lumberjacks answered with

two runs of their own, knotting the game as both teams moved into the late innings.

But the visitors would not be denied.

Continental plated three runs in the sixth, capitalizing on defensive miscues that rarely plague Water Oak. The vaunted Lumberjack defense showed cracks in both the sixth and seventh innings, and Continental took full advantage. Water Oak managed just one more run, trailing 7-5 after six. The visitors added three more in the seventh and then slammed the door in the eighth, closing out a 10-5 victory.

Erik Pearson paced Continental with a perfect 3-for-3 performance, including a double. Frank Snyder went 3-for-4, while George Russell drew three walks and created constant pressure on the basepaths.

For Water Oak, Dave Sargent continued his hot stretch at the plate, going 3-for-4 with two doubles. Jack Uriah reached base three times, finishing 2-for-3 with a walk. Mladen Mehes added a double, and Dan Shaffer worked two walks to keep innings alive.

It was not the outcome the Lumberjacks wanted. Yet even strong teams stumble on occasion. The mark of a first-place club is not perfection but perseverance.

Water Oak remains at Russell Field next week as they prepare to host Sun Lake. The hope is that the Friday the 13th cloud lifts quickly and that the familiar roar of victory returns for Division 7 team.
